

PROJECT NAME: **DELEVOE PARK EXPANSION AND OVERFLOW PARKING**

PROJECT LOCATION: 2520 N.W. Sixth St., Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This 36-acre neighborhood park opened in 2002. Programming at the park includes classes, club and association meetings, the After-School Program, and the Summer Recreation Program. The 2.5-acre site adjacent to the park was developed to provide for 72 overflow parking stalls including 5 handicapped, a Gazebo with water fountain, a pedestrian exercise path around a retention area, site lighting, and landscaping and irrigation.

THOMPSON & ASSOCIATES ROLE:

As the Engineer of Record T&A was responsible for developing the site plan based on a preliminary sketch developed by staff, preparation of the demolition plans, paving grading and drainage plans, water and sewer plans, pavement markings and signage plans, details and specification, and storm water pollution prevention plans. The scope also included submitting an environmental resource permit and stormwater management permit to Broward County and coordinating with all sub-consultants for building permits. Post design services were limited to review of shop drawings and response to request of information from the contractor.
