

PROJECT NAME: **FLORIDA KEYS OVERSEAS HERITAGE TRAIL**

PROJECT LOCATION: Monroe County, Florida

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection in partnership with the Florida Department of Transportation funded the planning, design, permitting, and construction of a pedestrian and bicycle path from Key Largo to Key West. The 8' to 12' wide bike path is being completed in various segments and face unique challenges, such as environmentally sensitive area, hurricane safety, and bridge reconstruction. The project included facilities for fishing, biking, jogging and walking, as well as local information stations. The segment that was coordinated and inspected by T&A was from Layton to Channel 5 Bridge, mile marker 68.4 TO 70.8.

T&A was the Project Manager and Engineer-of-Record for the CEI effort.
