

PROJECT NAME: **Happy Hollow Road**
PROJECT LOCATION: Palm Beach County, Florida

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Development of a 2,500 student Charter School required off-site improvements. The school development required a ¼ mile length of new roadway, Happy Hollow Road, and a new signalized intersection with Lyons Road. The new road was a curb and gutter section with a three (3) and four (4) lanes facility primarily used for the school traffic. Additional sidewalk was also added for safe pedestrian movements. The roadway design included lane transitions, shoulder improvements, ADA improvements and a full drainage design which met FDOT, Palm Beach County Roadway Production Division, SFWMD, and LWDD criteria.

THOMPSON & ASSOCIATES ROLE:

As the Engineer-of-Record, Thompson & Associates, Inc. completed the roadway design plans including roadway sections, drainage design and calculations, pavement marking and signage plans, and SWPPP plans. Special accommodations were incorporated into the design for equestrian users of the corridor which historically utilized this prior to development.
