PROJECT DESCRIPTION:	
The Central County Neighborhood Improvements Project (CCNIP) included 1,682 acres, 21,300 residents, and 5,029 homes with 970 septic tanks. The planned improvements for the area include 53 miles of roadways, 35 miles of sidewalk, and 84 miles of pipeline and is split into 12 construction packages.

James Thompson, PE was the engineer-of-record for 18 miles of roadway, drainage and sidewalk improvements for the neighborhoods of Franklin Park (BP2 – 4 miles of roadways), Washington Park (BP5 – 6 miles of roadways), St. George East (BP11 – 4 miles of roadways), and St. George West (BP8 – 4 miles of roadways). He also assisted a team of consultants in completing the Basis of Design Report which analyzed the entire CCNIP project area and developed design standards and regional solutions to water, sewer, drainage and roadway issues.
