PROJECT DESCRIPTION:	
<p>The North Andrews Gardens Neighborhood Improvement Project (NAGNIP) included 712 acres, 9,000 residents, 2,600 septic tanks, and 3,600 homes. The completed improvements included 29 miles of roadways, 83 miles of pipe, and 53 miles of sidewalk. The area is bounded by Cypress Creek Road (NE 62nd Street), Interstate 95 (I-95), Prospect Road, and NE 6th Avenue / NE 9th Avenue and is divided into 8 construction bid packages.</p>

<p>James Thompson, PE was the engineer-of-record for five (5) bid packs, which included 18 miles of roadway, drainage and sidewalk improvements. Darren Badore was the Project Manager for the entire project from Basis of Design Report through construction completion. The Roadway improvements included 1.3 miles of Andrews Avenue (4-lane, curb and gutter, divided roadway) and 0.75 miles of Commercial Boulevard (FDOT S.R. 870).</p>
